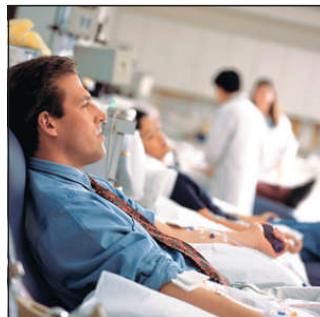


Happy New Year!
